Research showed a lack of characters with disabilities in the stories children are presented with. Moreover, even if characters with disabilities are represented, they are often inaccurately portrayed. In addition, many stories often used in schools may have an outdated understanding of disability (UNESCO, 2020). Thus, it is evident that there is a need for the creation of stories and books that appropriately depict characters with disabilities and with which pupils with disabilities can identify, develop a positive understanding of themselves and realise that they have experiences in common with others.
